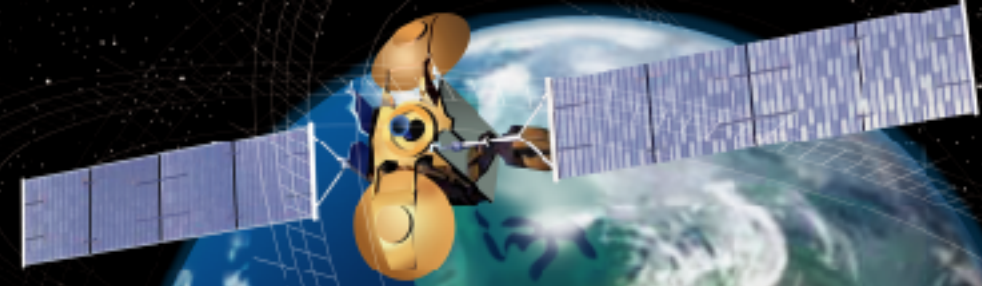

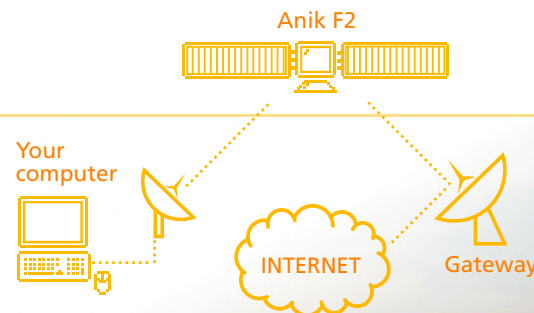
With our 'Always On' connection, you get the speed you need to connect your business to the world, access up-to-the-minute news sources, download files or just surf the web.



Infosat Mini-dish (67cm)
Incorporating the latest in microwave carrier technologies, the Infosat mini-dish receives signals from and transmits signals to the Anik F2 satellite. Infosat's highly trained and certified professionals will accurately align the mini-dish with the orbiting satellite, ensure all necessary connections are completed, and mount the mini-dish properly and securely at the location.



Satellite Modem
The satellite modem is a small signal transfer receiver which connects to your computer. It is used to connect your computer to the Infosat network. A cable from the dish will connect to the satellite modem which will be linked either directly into your computer or into a Router.



What is the HSe service and where is it available?
HSe is a high-speed Internet access service for homes, offices and businesses and is available virtually anywhere in Canada.

Why should I get HSe? Because you get reliable, quick and easy Internet access via an 'Always On' connection with no dialing, no waiting and no login required.

Do customers need a phone line in addition to the HSe service? No, this is a 2-way, high-speed Internet service that requires no phone line connection.

Will I be able to attach more than one computer or user to the service? Yes, the service will support a number of concurrent users, IP addresses and TCP/IP connections.

Can I get your HSe service in a vehicle like a truck, tractor or RV? No, this service is currently designed only for stationary computers.

What does it cost? This service is the most affordable satellite Internet service available in Canada. There are two costs - a fee for the equipment plus professional installation, and a low monthly service fee for the high-speed access.
